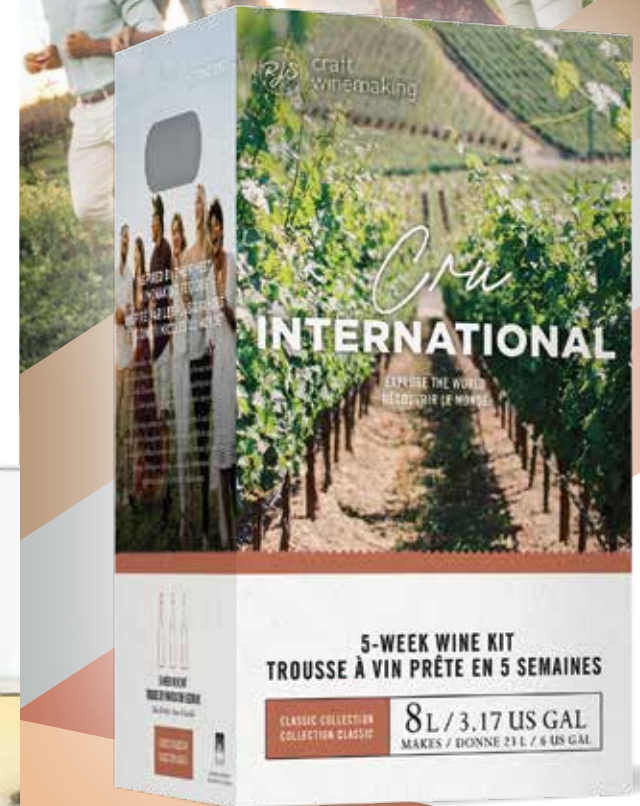

| Merlot Style             | <b>NEW</b><br>Chile Merlot Style          | Chilean Merlot tends to be full-bodied yet gentle, with bracing acidity, it pairs perfectly with creamy Gorgonzola.  |
| Valpola Style            | <b>NEW</b><br>Italy Valpola Style         | From the famous Italian red wine region Veneto, this easy-drinking, deep, ruby-red wine has distinct aromas of ripe cherries and dried fruits.   |
| Vieux Chateau du Roi     | <b>NEW</b><br>France Vieux Chateau du Roi | From one of the largest wine producers in the world, this rich French red is a complex blend of various French grape varieties. Dark in colour and high in tannin, this wine leaves a nice hint of plum on the palate. |
